President's Report

Happy Thanksgiving to everyone at The Wells, and I do hope that all of us can take a little time out and truly give thanks for all of our many blessings. It is very easy to get caught up with our ever present aches and pains and other problems, that many times we forget that we are very fortunate in other areas of our lives.

On the home front I want to remind all you the need to be alert and safe at all times. The recent break-ins and attempted break-in involving several vehicles brings the safety issue to the forefront. If you see something that makes you uncomfortable: notify the police.

There seems to be a couple of rumors circulating that; 1. The Board is cancelling our cable contract, and 2. The Board will not allow the concerts provided by Bill, Kevin and friends to take place. Let me assure you that is not the case. **THE RUMORS ARE BOTH ABSOLUTELY FALSE.**

The refurbished recreational facilities are finished and are currently being used to the delight of all participants. The transition of the west tennis court to a multiuse court will be studied and acted upon in the near future. Watch for a posting of a demonstration and noise study for pickleball. The Board is also looking to possibly convert the existing semi functional golf green to a fully functional turf golf green. This will be studied and acted upon, if approved in the next two months.

Please note that notices from the city of Mesa concerning the recycling program have been distributed to homeowners. This is an ongoing concern and constantly changing. Please follow the printed regulations and if you're in doubt or unsure then throw it in the trash.

Now that our streets and recreational projects have been completed, we will turn to the aging clubhouse. Though it serves our purpose very well at this time, it is in need of some upgrades. Over the next several years we will be looking at flooring, roof, windows and doors as major projects to be undertaken. Finance has assured us that all of the above renovations, among others, are well within our budget capabilities. A committee involving The Board, Clubhouse, B&G as well as interested homeowners will be formed to study the need and priority for these upgrades.

Finally, the next Board meetings will be Tuesday, December 3rd at 8:30am in the board room, and then the monthly meeting on Wednesday, December 18th at 7:00pm in the clubhouse. You will not want to miss the meeting on the 18th as the new budget for 2020 will be presented and acted upon. See you then.

If you are painting, attach a sample of the colors you selected. There is a color book in the HOA Office that contains approved colors. It also contains approved colors for driveways and planter boxes. If you have any questions when filling out the ARC form, contact one of the ARC members for assistance. If you are doing any remodeling on the outside of your house, attach a drawing of your plan along with the dimensions. You **must** wait for approval before you begin the work. Then post the yellow copy of the form on the front window of your house until the work is completed.

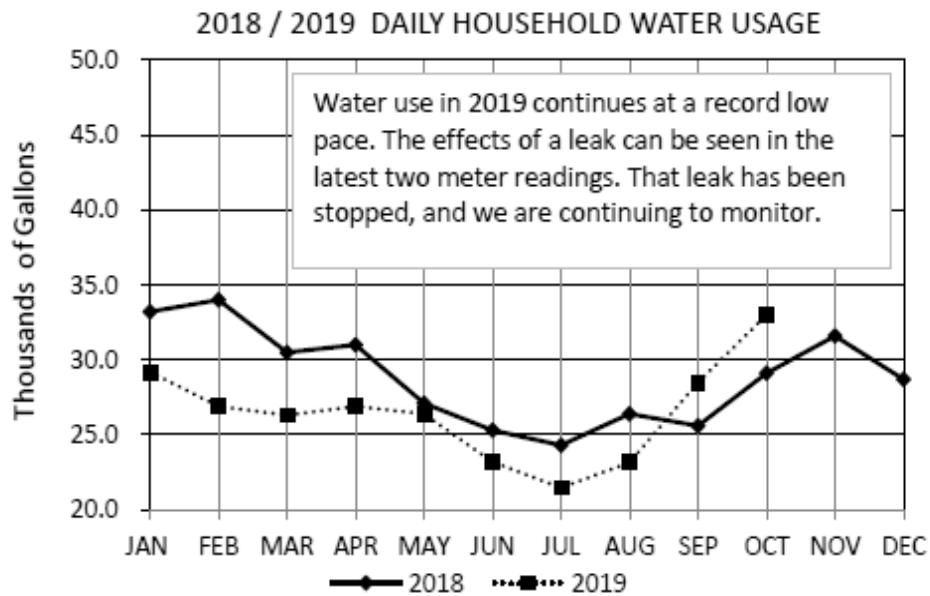

THE WELLS BOARD OF DIRECTORS ELECTION for 2020

The 2020 HOA Election is fast approaching and we are still looking for dedicated, hardworking individuals who have the best interest of the Wells and all residents in mind. There will be two (2) positions open for the Wells HOA Board of Directors. Directors are elected for a three (3) year term. There are no term limits.

If you are interested in one of these positions, file a Letter of Intent and a one hundred (100) word or less resume with the Election Committee. (Note: Please do not go over the 100 words limit). Forms to file are in the HOA office. Return the completed documents to the HOA office. The cutoff date for filing is by the close of business day on the second Friday of December (December 13, 2019) for your name to be on the ballot. Absentee Ballots will be available the first week of January 2020.

Please note: According to the CC&R's Section 5.3 Voting Rights Item B: "Units owned by corporations, family trusts, or non-residents, are entitled to one (1) vote for which a proxy determining who is casting the vote must be on file with the HOA at least ten (10) days prior to an election." If you fall into this category, please go to the HOA office and sign the appropriate form.

- December 13th, 2019: Cut-off date for candidates to file and have their names placed on the printed ballot
- January 22, 2020: Meet the Candidates Night" at 7:00 PM in the clubhouse. Anyone announcing their candidacy this night, may do so, but will have to be a write-in vote on the ballot.
- February 4, 2020: Election Day – Polls open 10AM -6:00 PM in the clubhouse.
- February 19, 2020: Homeowner's Annual Meeting – 7:00 PM in the clubhouse.
