## President's Report

Many things happened at the Annual Board of Directors (BOD) meeting on February 15th. Congratulations to Barb Mountain for being elected for another term on the Board & welcome to Joe Lander on his election to the Board. We approved the remaining work to complete the project at the West dumpster and a 200 foot long x 3 foot wide sidewalk was approved for the East side of the Clubhouse along Wells Drive. We hope this will provide a safer walkway for our residents. The BOD also approved a 700 square foot plot of Kurapia ground cover at the SE side of the Clubhouse to see if this type of "grass" will be viable for our Community.

Almost everyone has responded to the issue of their planter boxes. The first inspection on November 11th identified 113 homes out of compliance and courtesy letters were written to these homeowners. The next follow-up on January 20th found 69 homes that needed attention and violation letters were written. Then on January 31st 12 homes were fined for not responding to the violation letters. Of these, less the 6 homes still need to respond to the fines concerning their planter boxes. Please continue to maintain your planter boxes.

The 2023 budget was approved at the December 16, 2022 BOD meeting with no increase in the General Assessments. So as of March 1st, dues will remain at \$136 for a single lot, \$156 for a 1 & 1/2 lot and \$178 for a 2 lot property.

Thanks to all of your volunteer time especially given this past month. There are more details from Committees and Clubs found elsewhere in this Wellspoken on many of the activities that occurred in February.

Homeowners who are going to alter landscape, or do any work on the outside of their home, need to get approval from the ARC committee.

ARC Committee meets the first and third Thursday of each month at 9:00 am in the conference room. Pick up and return your completed ARC Request Form to the HOA Office prior to the next ARC meeting. If you are painting, attach a sample of the colors you selected. There is a color book in the HOA Office that contains approved colors. It also contains approved colors for driveways and planter boxes. If you have any questions when filling out the ARC form, contact one of the ARC members for assistance. If you are doing any remodeling on the outside of your house, attach a drawing of your plan along with the dimensions. A recommended list of plants for the planter box and the side of the home is in the HOA office.

You **must** wait for approval before you begin the work. Then post the yellow copy of the form on the front window of your house until the work is completed.

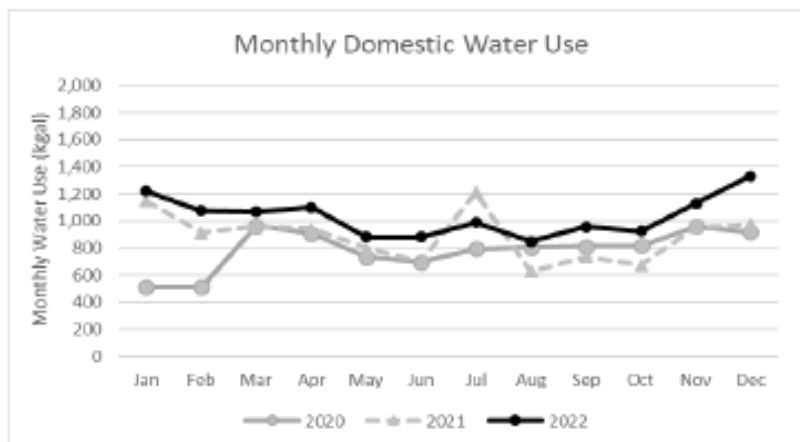

## Demographic Report for Beginning of 2023

There are 422 homes at The Wells. The demographics I will be sharing will be for 397 homes which does not include the seasonal rentals. I will be using the term "snowbirds" to indicate part time residents.

How many people live at The Wells? 593.

What is the average age - Men? 75 ; Women? 75.

When talking about the homes (not the number of people), what percentage of homes do you think are occupied by "snowbirds"? 52%.

What percentage of the homes are occupied full time? 48%.

What % of the people are "Snowbirds"? 61%. Full time? 39%.

What % of the residents are Men? 42% . Women? 58% .

Ages : Males range from 56 to 96. Females range from 45 to 99.

Snowbirds come from 24 states and 7 Canadian Provinces. The state with the most snowbirds is Minnesota with 94. Next is Iowa with 40, Wisconsin 33, Washington 28, Canada 28, North Dakota 21.
