HOA President's Report.

At the December 20, 2023 Homeowners meeting the Board of Directors approved the 2024 budget that includes an increase of \$4.00 to the general monthly assessment. The monthly assessment for each size lot effective MARCH 1, 2024 will be as follows:

Due to issues with the USPS delivering Courtesy & Violations letters in a timely manner we will begin to use email along with traditional "snail mail" to notify homeowners of issues with your property. There are still about 35-40 homes that don't have an email address registered with the HOA Office. If you are one of these homeowners that has email access, please give your information to the HOA Office.

We continue to have some sewer line issues. If you think that you may have a Common Area sewer line clog please contact the HOA Office during normal business hours so that we may help identify the issue before hiring a plumber. But, in a true emergency or after hours you may need to hire a plumber on your own.

Also, we continue to find contamination (clothes, kitchen & office supplies, etc) in the white Sunshine Acres aluminum recycle bin. Please only recycle aluminum cans (pop & beer) in this bin. We have other small cans along side of our large dumpsters for other type of recycling, including clear plastic water bottles and clean steel cans. A local resident will pick up these recyclables and he has stated that he no longer is going through the large dumpsters unless there is something of interest sitting on the top of the dumpster pile. He is not going through any sealed garbage bags.

Finally, thanks to all of our committees and volunteers who continue to give of your 3 T's (Time, Talent & Treasure) to help us maintain our Community. Have a Happy New Year! -Jim Riedl President


