If you are painting, attach a sample of the colors you selected. There is a color book in the HOA Office that contains approved colors. If you are doing any remodeling on the outside of your house, attach a drawing of your plan along with the dimensions. A recommended list of plants for the planter box and the side of the home is in the HOA office. You **must** wait for approval before you begin the work. Then post the yellow copy of the form on the front window of your house until the work is completed.

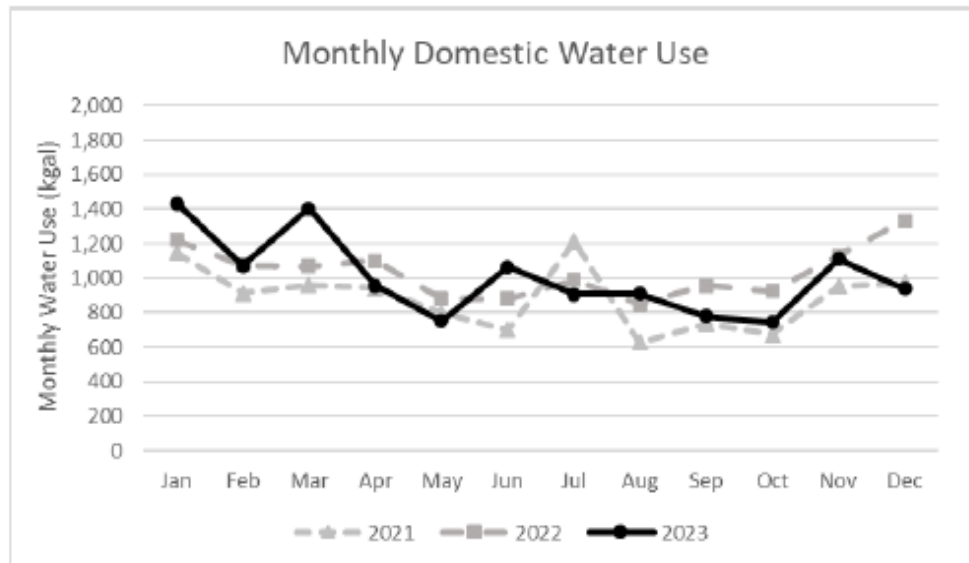

The election committee is pleased to see an uptick in the percentage of eligible voters turning out for election either in person or by absentee voting. The following is a comparison of previous years:

**2013 – 70%; 2014 – 60%; 2015 – 63.9%; 2016 – 55.8%; 2017 – 49%; 2018 – 54%;  
2019 – 43%; 2020 – 38.4%; 2021 – 30.03%; 2022 – 32.7%; 2023 – 45.7%; 2024 – 50.7%**

**\*\*\*\*\* Please be aware\*\*\*\*\* In light of the confusion surrounding properties owned by Trusts, LLC's, Corporations or Partnership, the HOA board passed a Resolution at the February 13, 2024 HOA Board Meeting allowing owners to sign a one-time only Voter Eligibility Form. This form will be good until property is sold or until another designated person is appointed. Hopefully, this will eliminate many problems. Future open meetings by the election committee on this topic will be held prior to the next election cycle in 2025.**

### Demographic Report for Beginning of 2024

There are 422 homes at The Wells. The demographics I will be sharing will be for 397 homes which does not including the seasonal rentals. I will be using the term “snowbirds” to indicate part time residents.

How many people live at The Wells? **592.**

What is the average age of Men? **75**, Women? **73.**

When talking about the homes (not the number of people), what percentage of homes do you think are occupied by “snowbirds”? **52%.**

What percentage of the homes are occupied full time? **48%.**

What % of the people are “Snowbirds”? **61%**, Full time? **39%.**

What % of the residents are Men? **43%**, Women? **57%.**

**Ages:** Males range from: **56 to 96**, Females range from: **46 to 101.**

Snowbirds come from 24 states and 7 Canadian Provinces.

The state with the most snowbirds is Minnesota with **86**. Next is Iowa with **38**, Wisconsin **35**, Washington **34**, Canada **29**, North Dakota **22.**

Number of trusts:**102** Corporations (etc.): **8**, Total **110.**
