

It was great to see the many guests visiting the wells residents for spring break. We would like to remind everyone to please familiarize yourselves and guests with our Rules and Regulations. There were multiple pool violations this year. Children under that age of 4 are not allowed in the pools and there is NO diving allowed. Residents are responsible for their guests conduct.

As the season begins to wind down for many, please don't forget to fill out a departure form. Be sure to include the information of any caretakers watching over your property. We have made great strides in keeping the community landscaping and maintenance violations to a minimum. Lets keep this going through the summer! If you are in need of a bulk trash or appliance pick up contact the office. We can schedule a pick up with City of mesa. There is a charge of \$19.00 for appliance and \$9.00 for Bulk.

Friendly reminder: <u>Pick up fruit as it falls</u>. This helps keep rodents and pests to a minimum. Fallen fruit becomes food for rodents and other unwanted creatures. A few dead rats have been found around the community. Please make a conscious effort to keep up with control of weeds/landscaping to help keep the community beautiful year round. The office will continue to give notices for weeds and other violations. Be sure your lots are in "neat and clean condition".

Homeowners who are going to alter landscape, or do any work on the outside of their home, need to get approval from the ARC committee. ARC Committee meets the first and third Thursday of each month at 9:00 am in the conference room. Pick up and return your completed ARC Request Form to the HOA Office prior to the next ARC meeting. If you are painting, attach a sample of the colors you selected. There is a color book in the HOA Office that contains approved colors. It also contains approved colors for driveways and planter boxes. If you have any questions when filling out the ARC form, contact one of the ARC members for assistance. If you are doing any remodeling on the outside of your house, attach a drawing of your plan along with the dimensions. A recommended list of plants for the planter box and the side of the home is in the HOA office. You **must** wait for approval before you begin the work. Then post the yellow copy of the form on the front window of your house until the work is completed.



On a Personal Note

For many years, Raintree Landscaping has been taking good care of the common areas here in The Wells, and I for one, am grateful for all the hard work they've given us. Many of you heard the news last year that Rose (aka, "Rosie") Pfaltzgraff, co-owner of Raintree Landscaping (alongside her husband of 23 years, Mike Pfaltzgraff), was diagnosed with Stage 4 liver and colon cancer. For many months, we have missed seeing her sunny face working with her crew around the park here. As you can imagine, today, she is much thinner and easily fatigued, but has had to return to work (against her doctor's orders) in doing the landscaping here in the park because her husband, Mike, who had retired a few years ago due to health issues, died suddenly on Feb 16th of a massive heart attack at home. What else can happen to this sweet family? Rosie and Mike have three sons--the oldest is 21 and has joined his mother in working and managing the business, while Rosie is once again driving the trucks for them. Their other two boys are still in school - one in high school, and the other in junior high. At the time of Mike's death, a GoFundMe page was set up to help Rosie with Mike's funeral expenses. But as you can imagine, their needs continue. Much of what has been raised so far went to Mike's funeral last month, so they need our help. After the many years of very hard work they have poured into this park, including many individual residences (like mine), I ask you to PLEASE DONATE--and often--to this fund to help Rosie with her medical expenses, and to help her boys with their futures.
