The 2025 Operating Budget is being developed by the Finance Committee with plans to present the first pass to the BOD and Community at the December 3rd BOD meeting with the final budget to be voted on at the December 18th BOD meeting. Please plan on attending these meetings to see the budget process in action and where your monthly assessments are spent.

The Ad Hoc Clubhouse Utilization Committee has finally completed their commission to improve and enhance our Clubhouse. I have asked them to give a final report of the line items & total cost for these improvements at one of the December BOD meetings. Thank you to all those involved with this effort, especially Bob Tomasic, as AD Hoc Chair and Sharon Nelson as the Clubhouse Chair and the support from the HOA Office.

18 new chairs have been purchased for the Card Room and as of this writing most of the old chairs have been sold.

Bingo is still on target for a January 2025 start. More information will be available later this month.

The ARC Committee meets the first and third Thursday of each month at 9:00 am in the conference room. Pick up and return your completed ARC Request Form to the HOA Office prior to the next ARC meeting. If you are painting, attach a sample of the colors that you selected. There is a color book in the HOA Office that contains approved colors. It also contains approved colors for driveways and planter boxes. If you have any questions when filling out the ARC form, contact one of the ARC members for assistance. If you are doing any remodeling on the outside of your house, attach a drawing of your plan along with the dimensions. A recommended list of plants for the planter box and the side of the home is in the HOA Office. You **must** wait for approval before you begin the work. After approval, post the yellow copy of the form on the front window of your house until the work is completed.

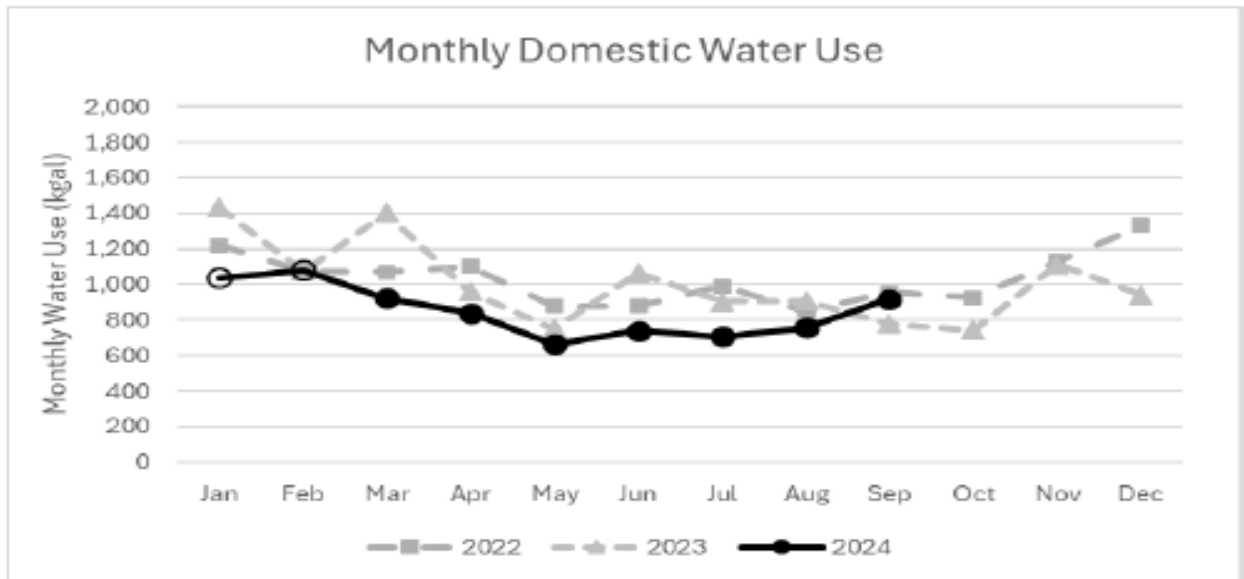
