Another hot dry summer is behind us and temps are finally beginning to come down. We lost a few shrubs here and there but all in all things look pretty good considering the dust storms, lack of a real monsoon season, and again, record setting temperatures. We are currently making an effort to address the weed problem in the East greenway. We also expect to complete the project of replacing 3 sprinkler heads in the West greenway that are troublesome. Our effort to compile a report for the board concerning the upgrading of the spa pool is almost complete and should be available to the board at their first meeting in November. The board will also have a written plan for review concerning the construction of an access path to the north desert area. A plan to enhance the entryway on 56th surfaced late last winter but was tabled due to scheduled construction by the city to upgrade our water supply valves and meters. I expect that project to resurface soon. On the last workday of spring, 2025, a crew was assigned to survey the perimeter wall. Addressing what might need to be acted on according to that survey will also be on our to-do list this winter season.


