Good day to everyone here in The Wells Community and as I write this article, we are experiencing a semi rare rain shower.

First things first, our primary concern at this time to ensure that our transition to the new gate system runs as smoothly as it possibly can. Make sure that you come to the office to pick up your new gate FOB and familiarize yourself with the process to open the gates. If you have any problems with it, the office staff is here to help you.

A secondary issue that I feel a need to address is safety concerns within the community. We are now approaching the time when we are close to full occupancy and safety becomes more critical. There are many homeowners out and about with a number of them facing mobility issues. Therefore, it is essential that drivers and those with golf carts be well aware of, and follow our speed limits so, that we are not endangering anyone. We have several times in the past talked about the use of speed bumps throughout the community. Even though those talks have never moved beyond the talking state, the issue is heating up again. Safe speed and safety on our streets is a must and remember "only you can prevent speed bumps."

HOA Manager's Report

The McDowell Gate is fully operational. The smaller system box was replaced with a larger one to provide a more aesthetically pleasing look and integrate the SRP and Fire Access Controls into the box instead of having them mounted to the outside.

We are still waiting for Blue Stake to complete the markings for the 56th Street Gate before Junto Tech can sawcut the entrance. They are running behind because of the rain. Work will begin Monday December 1st.

Once they saw-cut, that entrance will be closed until we finish the install, which will take about 4-5 days. We will re-open it as soon as possible, if things go quicker than anticipated.

Junto Tech spent 2 days at the McDowell entrance and helped residents understand how to use the FOBs. The FOBs are programmed, and the Guest Access PIN is working as well. They are also working with the manufacturer on a more simple, user-friendly version of the mobile app, that should be available for release soon.

If you are experiencing issues with your FOBs please bring them to the HOA office. Please see the photo attached on the last page of the Wellspoken.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION

Please note: According to the CC&R's Section 5.3 Voting Rights Item B: "Units owned by corporations, family trusts, or non-residents, are entitled to one (1) vote for which a proxy determining who is casting the vote must be on file with the HOA at least **ten (10) days prior to an election.**" If you fall into this category, you will be receiving a letter from The Wells HOA with a Proxy and/or Voter Eligibility form to be returned by January 23, 2026. If you filled out one of these forms in 2024 or 2025 you will not need to fill out another form. These forms will no longer expire after 11 or 25 months. **Please check with the HOA office if you are unsure if you signed.** If this form is not filled out and filed in the HOA office, residents holding property as described above will not be able to vote.
