Wow, December has moved on very quickly and a new year is here. Now you can enjoy the atmosphere, ambience, and the special feelings that Christmas brought to each of us. **Happy New Year** to all from Carol and me and we do hope that you have a safe, healthy and prosperous new year.

If you were in attendance at the Wednesday, December 17th HOA Board meeting, you know that many things are happening within The Wells Community. Of note was the passage of an \$800,000 + budget for the 2026 calendar year which will require a dues increase of \$5.00 per month starting on March 1, 2026. This is a very modest increase and represents very diligent and meticulous work by our finance committee.

You will see the new lighting project completed in the recreation area, improvements in the new gate system that will allow it to work at more efficient level, improvements in landscaping, as well as some other necessary, but not as visible, projects. Irrigation will be of major concern as we start 2026 and we confront the rising cost of water in Mesa as well as the entire valley. Another area of concern will see the improvement in our streets as we will go through a program to fill the cracks and seal coat to ensure that we get maximum life from our asphalt.

Once again, we ask that you be aware of your fellow homeowners and try to maintain the security and safety that is of utmost importance in our community. HOA President, Bob Tomasic #41

There is a color book in the HOA Office that contains approved colors. It also contains approved colors for driveways and planter boxes. If you have any questions when filling out the ARC form, contact one of the ARC members for assistance. If you are doing any remodeling on the outside of your house, attach a drawing of your plan along with the dimensions. A recommended list of plants for the planter box and the side of the home is in the HOA Office. You **must** wait for approval before you begin the work. After approval, post the yellow copy of the form on the front window of your house until the work is completed.

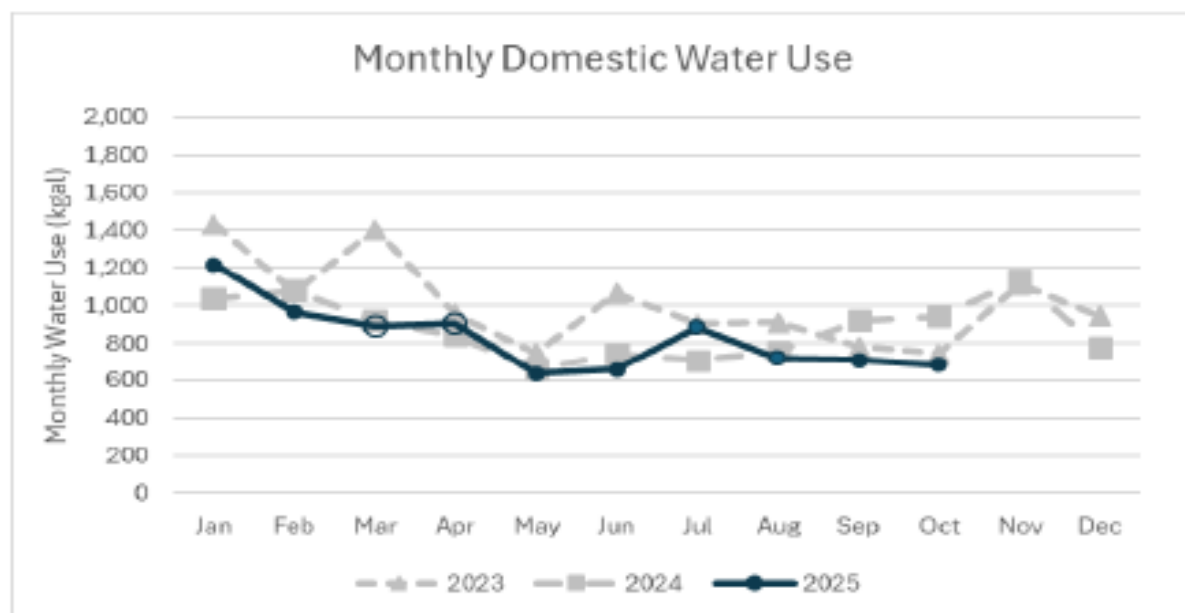
